<u>Minutes</u>

In attendance: Mrs Blanden, Mrs Williams, Ms Page and 6 parents

1. <u>Welcome</u>

Parents were welcomed with a prayer. Apologies made for those who could not attend.

2. Action points from previous meeting

- Walk to school-contact was made with 'Jambusters'. Travel plan is at the second draft stage. Aim is to complete in September 2019 (will need parent volunteers/staff member).
- Pedestrian gate-site manager made enquiries and was given the information that this would cost £3500 to reset the gate to remain open at beginning/end of the day (would have to come from the school's 'Capital' budget). Discussed moving the railings at the road entry-no definitive response from the Local Authority to date as to responsibility before re-siting can take place.
 ACTION: Chain will be removed until an answer from the council is received.
 Parents agreed it was safer to cross.
 ACTION: Pedestrian gate timing? (not always open at 2.45pm for parents) Site manager to look into this.
- Gate opening a.m/p.m- staff briefings now begin 5 minutes earlier in the mornings. 3p.m. gate opening much better.
- Shelter area: 'Jambusters' –grant funding applied for-waiting for the outcome of the bid. Should hear after 14.6.19. Will also need funding from the school 'Capital' budget.
- P.E-The school follow the Long term PE plan. All staff have been guided to ensure asthma pumps for pupils are easily accessible during PE times.
- ICT- Technician will be updating class pages on the website ready for September.
- Parent/teacher consultations-online facility from September 2019.
- Monies payments-online facility from September 2019.

• 'Holiday Club' information was sent out via e-mail. Hard copies will also follow. Agreed that going forward the ICT technician would investigate the use of electronic copies being available.
