Communication with Parents

Has been good throughout the lockdowns and the online learning was seen by many to be the best provision from all schools in the local area. The hiatus with EIS, class emails and lack of HomeConnect has been frustrating, although is being rectified by use of gmail. However, as a council, we need to engage parents further.

Discussion as to what contact parents already had with each other and what was easiest. WhatsApp groups are used but vary in impact from year group to year group. Some have all parents, some undersubscribed. There is little scope to meet or speak to other parents on the school site because of Covid measures.

Possibilities of zoom calls in year groups? Impractical because of mutually agreeable timings and WhatsApp groups would add to administrative pressure and difficult to keep points anonymised/ chats free of extraneous info.

The PC needs to be identifiable as a separate entity to the Friends.

Agreed that reporting to pec@stfranciscatholicprimary.com is easiest for YG reps and all parents.

<u>Introduction to members</u>

Parents need a visual introduction, rather than just a name to identify who the year group reps are. Members to send a photo and a short introduction to KP to send out with a newsletter. Point raised that many parents only know each other through children so links to their children would be beneficial, history within the school, etc.
